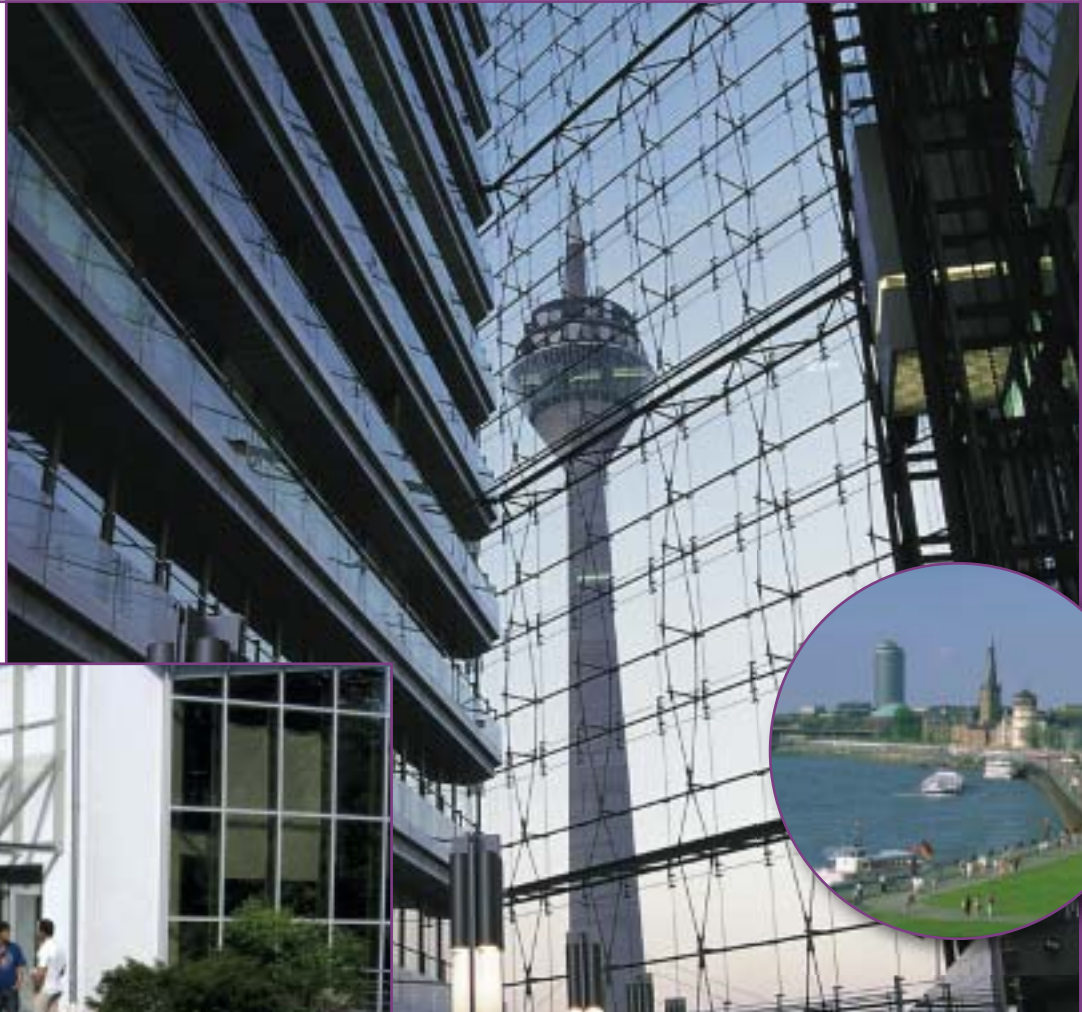
Our school is centrally located and offers bright classrooms, a cafeteria, internet access and a state-of-the-art E-learning-centre.

Dating back to 1159, the capital of North Rhine-Westphalia is a flourishing commercial centre and the fashion capital of Germany. It is also famous for producing glass, textiles and boasts Germany's first skyscraper, the Wilhelm-Marx-Haus, built in 1924.

Along with Cologne and Mainz, Düsseldorf is one of the strongholds of Rheinisch carnival. Between the 11th November and Ash Wednesday in Spring more than 600 parades and fancy dress balls take place. One of the most famous streets called the

Königsallee or the "Kö" as it is affectionately called by the locals, offers elegant shopping arcades and is one of the most beautiful boulevards in the world. In the direct vicinity of the "Kö" you will find the Altstadt. It is in the old quarter of the city. More than 260 cosy pubs offer home-brew taverns. The same area is home to famous art galleries and jewels of baroque architecture like St Andreas. One of the libraries even holds a collection of works by the poet of the German romantic movement Heinrich Heine.
